

Dear Member,

In September 2013, the U.S. Preventive Service Task Force recommended preventative coverage for breast cancer medications which reduce the risk of breast cancer (e.g., Tamoxifen or Raloxifene). Under the Affordable Care Act, any recommendations with a (A or B) rating should be covered one year from the recommendation and Health and Human Services under women's preventative care.

AultCare will implement all required coverage for this recommendation for all insured non-grandfathered plans on September 24, 2014. We will be working with self-insured employers to meet the coverage requirements as their plan year renews.

AultCare will make these medications available at no-cost to women age 35 and older if your doctor has prescribed them for the primary prevention of breast cancer. As required under the Affordable Care Act, these drugs are covered at no-cost if you have not had breast cancer, and your doctor has prescribed one of them to reduce your risk of developing breast cancer in the future.

Find out if you qualify for these drugs at no-cost to you:

1. If you are taking Raloxifene (brand name Evista) or Tamoxifen (brand name Nolvadex) for the prevention of breast cancer, print off the Breast Cancer Preventative Medications Enrollment form.
2. Take the form to your doctor. Have your doctor help you complete and fax the form to us at 330-363-3284, attention: AultCare Pharmacy Department. If you are not sure whether you qualify, talk to your doctor.
3. AultCare will review your diagnosis to determine if you qualify to receive these medications at no-cost. Please note that only the generic drugs are available at no-cost to you. The brand name forms of these medications may be applicable to your co-pay/coinsurance.
