

## **BD Insulin Syringes with the BD Micro-Fine IV Needle**

On February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023 BD announced a consumer-level recall of some lots of BD Insulin Syringes with the BD Micro-Fine IV Needle because of manufacturing issues that can result in unsealed packaging for the individual syringes. If the blister pack of the syringe has a nonintact seal, then there is a potential that the syringe is no longer sterile.

- Other BD insulin syringes that are not being recalled are available for patients to use

The recalled lots were distributed from June 2022 through October 2022

Per BD, use of a non-sterile syringe poses the risk of a local skin infection which may require medical treatment such as the use of antibiotics.

Anyone with an existing inventory of the recalled product should stop use, distribution and quarantine the product immediately.
